JURY HOLDS MANAGEMENT COMPANY ACCOUNTABLE IN ASSAULT OF HOMELESS MAN

DENVER, CO - A Denver jury has delivered justice for Early Jackson, awarding in excess of \$1 Million in his lawsuit against the largest amenity management company in the United States and two concierges who assaulted him at a downtown Denver luxury apartment building on a freezing January 2022 night.

As Mr. Jackson walked back to the Salvation Army shelter in freezing temperatures, he knocked on the door of a luxury high rise apartment building and asked to warm up briefly. The building's two 24-hour concierges initially allowed him to sit in the lobby. Minutes later, the concierges retrieved a handgun, before throwing him to the ground, and immediately dragging him out to the curb. Mr. Jackson was never given a reasonable opportunity to leave. As Mr. Jackson lay on the sidewalk, one of the concierges kicked him. The surveillance video of the assault was then intentionally deleted.

This verdict affirms a fundamental truth: every member of our community, regardless of their housing status or economic circumstances, deserves to be treated with basic human dignity and respect. No one should face violence simply for seeking shelter from the cold.
