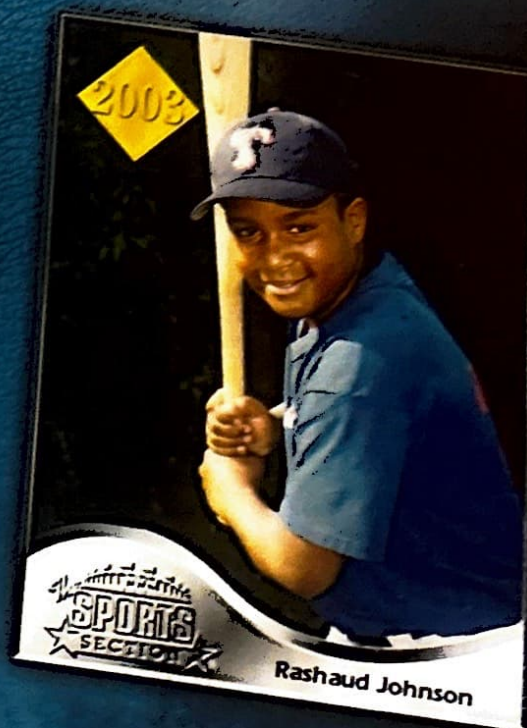
I Miss You Cousin Terrell-e-mon!

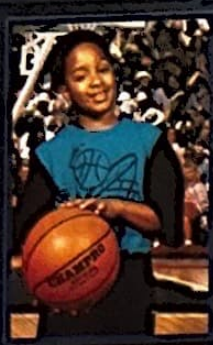

My dear grandson, I will hold you in my heart forever until I can hold you in my arms again in Heaven.

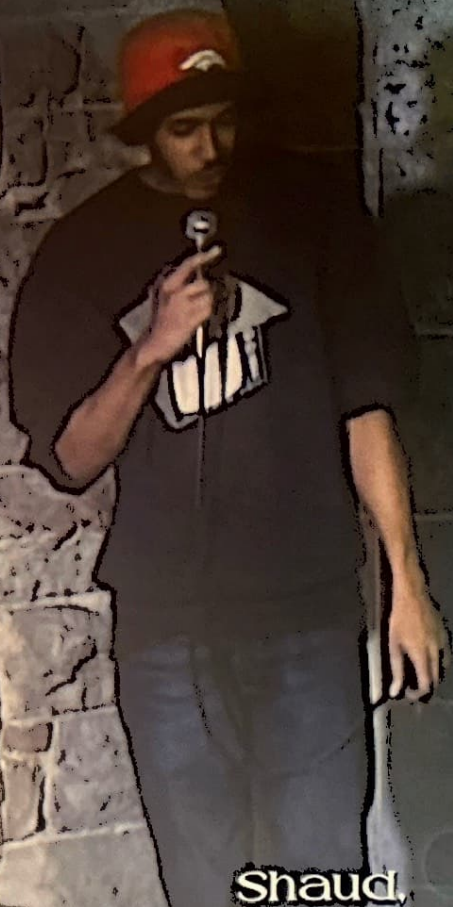
